aLIVE ISLAMIC PROGRAMME ACADEMIC YEAR 2021

May you and family be in the best of health and Iman, *by the Grace of Allah SWT*.

2 With reference to the announcement by MUIS dated on 21 December 2020, mosques are planning the gradual resumption of *face-to-face* aLIVE classes for Term 1 AY2021.

3 Your child has been placed in either Group 1/2/3 of the mosque’s aLIVE session. The rotation of the physical presence at Masjid Yusof Ishak will be as follows:

4 Our centre adopts blended learning approach in AY2021. During the week of HBL, your child is welcome to join the live session via zoom. Your child’s ustaz/ustazah will be sending the zoom details weekly for students on HBL. Attendance is counted based on physical and virtual presence in the class. However, we seek your understanding that our asatizah will focus on students who are physically presence. Teachers will continue to monitor the progress of your child through HBL quizzes and follow-up with them when they attend the lessons at the mosque.

5 We seek your understanding and cooperation in the following when sending your child to the mosque on the dates indicated above:

a) Health & Status	Parents/Guardians will be contacted by the mosque madrasah to fetch the child/ward if he/she is unwell while attending madrasah.
b) Reporting time for class and location.	Staggered entrance 15 min before class session ie: 7:45am, 11:15am & 2:15pm (weekend) Drop off point: MYI Gate. Our asatizah will be at the gate to usher your child in. Parents/ Guardians are to wait at designated areas and observe safe distancing.
c) Items students are to bring	Student Ezlink card/TT Token (if available) Learning materials: Class & Home Activity Books Own stationery Plastic bag for shoes Bottled water and light snacks (Students are advised to have their meals before class) Personal prayer items (prayer mat/telekung/ socks) Extra face mask
d) Dismissal time and pick-up location <i>Please be punctual as we are unable to provide a holding area for your child</i>	Staggered dismissal by class 15 minutes before session ends ie: 10:45am, 2:15pm, 5:45pm (weekend) Pick up Point: MYI Gate Parents/ Guardians are to wait at the designated areas and observe safe distancing.

6 The precautionary measures taken by the mosque madrasah include:

- ✓ Health and temperature screening of everyone entering the mosque madrasah.
- ✓ Staggered reporting time, breaks and dismissals.
- ✓ Students and teachers to wear masks.
- ✓ Fixed cluster or exam style allocated seating for students to maintain safe distancing and minimize intermingling.
- ✓ All mass events such as mass assemblies, congregational prayers with main congregation and group activities with close contact are suspended to minimize intermingling.
- ✓ Frequent cleaning of common areas and commonly touched surfaces. Wipe down of tables in classes after every session.
